CALIFORNIA PROPOSITION 65 Compliance Statement

California's Safe Drinking Water & Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 ("Proposition 65") requires businesses to notify Californians about significant amounts of chemicals in the products they purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By providing this information, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about protecting themselves from exposure to these chemicals. Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 establishes a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals which the state of California's risk assessment process has determined to cause cancer or birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust. The Proposition 65 chemical list can be found at:

Brooks will actively monitor our supply chain to ensure that it complies with the California Proposition 65 regulations. Brooks will compare any newly listed chemicals with the raw materials in our finished products and update our communications to our customers and concerned parties as necessary.
